Although the Olympics continue to be well-respected, they are hardly free of scandal or controversy. Scandals have occurred throughout Olympic history and have ranged from judging controversies to doping and corruption claims.

Concerning scandals, the use of performance-enhancing drugs has become the biggest challenge for Olympic officials since the 1960 Rome Olympics, when a Danish cyclist died of amphetamines his coach had given him. As a result, formal drug tests were initiated at the 1968 Winter Olympics in Grenoble, France. But due to the intense desire to win and gain fame and fortune, more and more athletes searched for a variety of performance-enhancing drugs that are difficult to discover. Canadian runner Ben Johnson participated in the Seoul Olympics in 1988 and won the 100-meter final in world-record time. However, he was stripped of his gold medal three days later after testing positive for stanozolol, a kind of steroid. In the 2016 Rio de Janeiro Games, some Russian athletes were banned from competing under their national flag due to widespread state-sponsored doping. However, Russian athletes were allowed to compete as neutrals.

But drugs are not the only problem. In the 2002 Winter Olympics held in Salt Lake City, for example, Canadian born figure skating pair Jamie Salé and David Pelletier were deprived of victory due to judging controversy. Prior to a skating competition, skaters provide a list of movements they intend to perform, which are supposed to have no impact on their score. A closing pose at the end of Salé and Pelletier's skating program was one of these. Unfortunately, Salé and Pelletier tripped and fell on their closing pose. Various news outlets inferred that, although the fall was not something that should have impacted their score, it actually did and landed them in second place behind a Russian skating pair.

During the 2008 Winter Olympics, Chinese gymnast He Kexin was caught up in controversy when media reports surfaced indicating she was too young to compete. The International Skating Union states that 16 is the minimum age for

participation. He Kexin's age was reported by Chinese newspapers as 13 in 2007 and 14 in 2008. They reported that her birth date on several registration lists of the Chinese General Administration was given as January 1, 1994, which made her 14 years, 220 days old during the opening ceremonies. Based on this information, an official investigation was launched, but the International Olympic Committee surprisingly ruled in He's favor.

Although scandals in the Olympics are part of its history, its reputation is never tarnished for long. The Olympics' overall clean reputation overshadows its scandals. Jamaican runner Usain Bolt, known as the fastest man alive, swimmer Michael Phelps, considered the most decorated Olympian of all time, and two-time Olympic gold-medalist figure skater Yuzuru Hanyu have not only excelled in their respective sports but have also left a legacy in the Olympic history for their outstanding integrity and sportsmanship. In fact, the majority of athletes follow these traditions.
